
"It is with the deepest of regrets and heaviest of hearts that I stand before you tonight", began the Lord Marshall.

"When the late then-Princess Nehemiah retook her rightful place on the throne, Archduke Stonehearth feared that as a result of her troublesome and rebellious childhood, the attempt on her life and her subsequent disappearance, and her having been removed from royal society for so long—he feared that these things left her unfit to rule, so much so that it would cause her to inadvertently place the Kingdom in danger. When he learned that Damasque felt similarly, the Archduke set in motion his plan to ascend the Duke to the throne.

"It wasn't long after the two had wed that the Queen became pregnant, and with the birth of Prince Regus, the King now had the heir

he needed to ensure his line remained on the throne. With his and the Archduke's plans nearly fully realized, only one task remained. It was then that King Damasque ended the Queen's life, mere moments after having brought their son into the world. It was a simple task for the King to spread the lie that his wife had died following her accouchement, but speaking as the Lord Marshall of the Jeredithian Inquisition, I implore you all; make no mistake—Nehemiah Varrow, daughter of King Regus and Queen Calithandra Varrow, did not die during childbirth—she was murdered."

"Earlier today, I was summoned to appear before the crown. As Sir Hendrickson of the Golden Briar here can attest to, the King proceeded to inform me of his decision to dissolve the Jeredithian Inquisition after having consulted with the Archduke. It was at this moment, just over a year since the Queen's murder, that it became clear that the two sought to eliminate the only power which could remove Damasque from the throne before they discovered the truth—a check on the crown's power nearly as old as the Kingdom itself which entrusted the Inquisition with the authority to remove the reigning monarchs should they themselves become a threat to their people—a check which, until now, has remained in place for over a thousand years without ever having been invoked."

"At my command, the Royal Guards, Sirs Hendrickson and Elision of the Order of the Golden Briar raised their weapons and turned towards Damasque. Drawing his blade, the former King refused to obey the laws set in place and maintained by his predecessors, leaving us with no choice but to attempt to subdue him by force so that he could appear before the people of this great city and answer to the loyal subjects he had forsaken."

"The two Inquisitors by my side and I were unable to reach the throne before Damasque was able to escape through Dorithan's Pass—a hidden crawlway constructed long ago for emergency use protected by a powerful enchantment that grants entry only to those which the one attuned to the crown wills it. The knights bravely attempted to apprehend the King but were quickly overcome by the his formidable combat skill, fatally wounding Sir Elision and nearly killing Sir Hendrickson before reaching the tunnel's entrance. The former King's current whereabouts are unknown, and he is currently wanted for the high crime of regicide."
